In compliance with Titles VI & VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, the Age Discrimination in Employment Act of 1967, the Americans with Disabilities Act, the Genetic Information Nondiscrimination Act of 2008, and Colorado law, Pueblo School District No. 60 does not unlawfully discriminate against otherwise qualified students, employees, applicants for employment or members of the public on the basis of race, color, creed, sex, sexual orientation, marital status, religion, national origin, ancestry, family composition, disability or need for special education services.
